## The Ada Courtice Certificate of Leadership and Learning

The certificate and pin are presented to a Home & School member who has successfully met the criteria in the **Volunteer Skills Portfolio**. Originally funded by a Trillium Grant, the program recognizes the development of members who have worked to extend their skills by being actively involved in a variety of areas including community involvement, communication, leadership and advocacy. Members register for the portfolio with the OFHSA office, then record their accomplishments and have them verified. Upon completion of the activities, the portfolio is forwarded to the Awards Workgroup.

### Federation Life Membership

Bestowed upon an individual who has made a significant contribution, through outstanding service, to the Federation. Presented by the OFHSA Board of Directors.

### Past-President's Pin

An excellent way to thank an outgoing Association or Council President and show appreciation for their hard work and the commitment shown throughout their term of office.

### Association Life Membership

Bestowed upon an individual who has made a significant contribution, through outstanding service, to a Home and School Association.

With Executive approval, an Association may purchase a pin and certificate to present to the deserving member. A Life Member of an association no longer has to pay the annual membership fee and has full membership rights.



Association Life Memberships come with a pin and certificate and cost \$50.

### Council President's Pin

A Home & School Council wishing to honour a current, new or outgoing Council President may present that individual with a Council President's pin. This is an excellent way to show appreciation.



Jeweller's quality: gold and blue with an enameled trillium. \$25.

### Council Life Membership

An individual who has served a Council in an outstanding way may be honoured with a Council Life Membership pin and certificate.

This recognition may also be given to someone who is not actively involved in Home and School, but who has made a significant contribution to the success of the Council.



Council Life Memberships come with a certificate and pin and cost \$50.

### Good to Know

The money received by the Federation from the sale of Association and Council Life Memberships is used to fund the OFHSA Citizenship Awards.

Each successful nominee is the recipient of a certificate and a cheque for \$100.
