About Alumni Memberships

Alumni memberships were first introduced at OFHSA in 2002. An active group of H&S members, whose children were all about to leave the public education system, saw a need; a way for them to remain members of OFHSA but not at the association level. Alumni memberships were created to fill this need.

Alumni memberships are available to those who were members of OFHSA in the past. Whether your child has left the system, their current school doesn't yet have an association or you have been away from public education for a while, alumni memberships are there for you.

Alumni memberships are single or family memberships (assuming both people were members of OFHSA). The alumni membership fee is **\$20** per year. The alumni membership year runs October 1st – September 30th annually.

Alumni memberships are purchased from the Federation.
